General Information

Who can attend Youth Garden Project Summer Camp?

YGP Summer Camp is open to all kids who will enter 6th grade in the fall of 20

What will YGP Summer Camp be like?

Every session of Summer Camp will be oriented around a different topic (see the opposite page), but all sessions will include regular camp activities like hiking, crafts, games, cooking, and activities in the Garden Mill. There are also opportunities for splashing around in Mill Creek or at the Moab City Pool. Some sessions also include field trips to other area places and spaces.

Where and when will YGP Summer Camp be held?

At the Youth Garden Project, of course! There are eight sessions of camp each year. Each session will run Monday through Friday, 9 am to 4 pm.

How much does it cost to attend YGP Summer Camp?

Each session costs \$100 per child. Supporting members of the Youth Garden Project receive 10% off per session. Siblings receive 10% off per session. Some scholarship funds are available: Keep reading to find out how to apply.

How do I register my child for YGP Summer Camp?

Fill out the enclosed registration form and return it to the Youth Garden Project. You can also access the registration form online at www.youthgardenproject.org. You can also email the form to programs@youthgardenproject.org. YGP Summer Camp is limited to 24 campers per session, and all sessions are first come, first served. Register soon! A \$10 deposit per camper per session is due with registration. The balance is due the first day of each session. After your registration is received, you will receive an enrollment confirmation notice.

How do I apply for scholarships for my child to attend YGP Summer Camp?

Thanks in part to the Grand County Special Service Recreation District, the Youth Garden Project is able to offer some scholarship assistance. If you would like to apply for scholarship funds, please fill out the registration in full, return it as directed above, and pick up a Scholarship Application Form at the Youth Garden Project. (A form will be emailed to you if you register via email.) Return the form as soon as possible: We will be in touch regarding assistance by May 21.
