### **C: Cooperation**

- Follow directions.
- Work as a team.

### **A: Attitude**

- Come ready to have fun!
- Come ready to try new things!

### **R: Respect**

- Please follow KYHFOOTY: “Keep your hands, feet, and other objects to yourself.”
- Be gentle with plants and animals at the Garden.
- Clean up after yourself.
- Please use an indoor voice in the Shafer House and the Garden Kitchen.

### **E: Empathy**

- Follow the Golden Rule: Treat others as you would like to be treated.
- Lend a helping hand to anyone who needs it.

### **S: Safety**

- Stay with the group at ALL times.
- Please walk, not run, on all Garden property, and please stay on the paths.
- Please walk your bike on all Garden property.
- Wash your hands after visiting animals.
- Be ready to drink lots of water!

Anyone who chooses to not follow the above expectations will:

1. Be given a verbal warning, and will discuss behavior with Summer Camp staff. Notice will be given to parent/guardian at end of day.
2. Be given a fifteen minute time-out, and will discuss behavior with Summer Camp staff. Notice will be given to parent/guardian at end of day.
3. Meet privately with Summer Camp staff and YGP Program Coordinator and/or YGP Executive Director. Parent/Guardian will be called immediately.
