Artichoke, Purple of Romagna	Italian, heirloom, Baker Creek Heirloom Seed co.	A regional Italian favorite, these large, round-headed purple artichokes are tender and tasty. Grows well in warm season areas. A great combination of beautiful and delicious.
Basil, Amethyst Improved	Purple. Johnny's Selected Seeds.	The only purple Genovese type basil. Large 2–3" wide leaves. This stunning basil is dark purple, nearly black in color, with edible flowers.
Basil, Cinnamon	Asian. Johnny's Selected Seeds.	Sweet cinnamon aroma. Tall, fast-growing plants have distinctive violet stems, with lavender blooms and 2" long leaves.
Basil, Genovese	Italian. Organic. Johnny's Selected Seeds.	Genovese Basil is a popular Italian pesto basil. Its flavor is slightly sweet and peppery. Easy to grow and adaptable—an excellent variety for home gardeners!

Eggplant, Orient Express	Asian, hybrid. Johnny's Selected Seeds.	A very dependable and early eggplant. Plants tolerate stress, and are easy to prepare in the kitchen. 8-10" long by 1 1/2-2 1/2" diameter, glossy purple fruit.
Flower, Gomphrena, Strawberry Fields	Johnny's Selected Seeds.	Best red gomphrena for cut flowers. Brilliant flowers, 1 1/2" across, atop strong stems. Plants are very productive, and hold color exceptionally well when dried. Also known as globe amaranth and Rio Grande globe amaranth.
Flower, Marigold, Durango	French	Extra-large blooms with outstanding uniformity, a mix of red, yellow, and orange. Highly branching plants. A good choice for packs, pots, and garden planting.
Flower, Marigold, Favourite.	French. Botanical Interests.	Bright mix of yellow, gold, red, and bicolor flowers that will lure butterflies to your garden. Compact, lacy plants are wonderful for borders and in containers.

Kale, Red Russian	Johnny's Selected Seeds.	Stems are purple; leaves are flat, toothed, and dark green with purple veins. The plants mature medium-tall and leaves are tender compared to other kales. For salads and light cooking.
Okra, Clemson Spineless	Green. Organic. Johnny's Selected Seeds.	This spineless heirloom variety of okra is the most popular. The tall plants produce medium-green pods. They are an attractive ornamental and the flowers are edible as well.
Pepper, Ancho Gigantea	Warm. Seed Savers Exchange.	This is the standard Mexican poblano pepper when fresh, called ancho when dried. The fruits are heart-shaped.
Pepper, Apple	Sweet. Organic, Seed Savers Exchange	The broad-shouldered, cone-shaped, very sweet peppers of this prolific variety reach 3" in length and ripen to all red on sturdy 24" plants.
Pepper, Chimayó	Mild chile. Heirloom. High Desert Seeds.	An heirloom from the tiny New Mexican village where it gets its namesake. It matures early, and makes an excellent chili powder that has a mild heat, with fruity, deep chocolate notes.
Pepper, El Jefe	Jalapeño, hot, hybrid. Johnny's Selected Seeds.	Best combination of earliness and yield in a jalapeno. Fruits avg. 3 1/2-4" on large plants.
Pepper, Jimmy Nardello	Sweet. Italian frying. High Desert Seed	This sweet pepper has a legendary sweet, rich flavor. The plant produces early-maturing long, thin, red Italian frying peppers that are less vulnerable to sunscald.
Pepper, Habanero	Heirloom, Very Hot. Organic. Johnny's Selected Seeds.	Wrinkled fruits ripen from dark green to orange. Extremely pungent fruits have a delicious exotic sweetness that accompanies the considerable heat.
Pepper, Hatch Big Jim	Warm. New Mexico green chile. Sandia Seed company.	This hot pepper has a great flavor with thick meaty pods. A famous variety from New Mexico in a region with a similar climate and elevation to Moab.
Pepper,	Sweet. organic.	Yellow and orange "Lunchbox" snack bell peppers have been combined in this mix. These

Pepper, Numex Joe E Parker	Warm. Open pollinated, Botanical Interests.	Great multipurpose chile for processing and fresh market. Medium-tall plant; for many the most productive traditional Anaheim type. Uniform fruits are the traditional semi-flattened shape.
Pepper, Serrano	Hot, heirloom. Botanical Interests.	Popular in Mexican cuisine, these peppers have a distinctive, spicy flavor required for many dishes. A versatile pepper for cooking, with prolific, productive plants.
Pepper, Shishito	Mostly mild, some hot. Snake River Seed Cooperative.	These rich and delicious thin skinned frying peppers are flavorful and mostly mild, with a one in ten chance of being hot. Best fried or grilled.
Pepper, Sugar Rush Peach.	Sweet and spicy. Baker Creek Heirloom Seed Company.	This snacking pepper is long and peach colored, packed with super sweet, tropical flavor. The seeds have a complex, smokey heat, which creates a great combination of flavor with the sweet fruit.
Squash, Honey Bear Acorn	Winter Squash. Johnny's Selected Seeds. Hybrid.	Early, large fruits with an attractive shape, and great flavor. Semi-bush plant. Avg. yield: 3-4 fruits/plant.
Squash, Spaghetti, Pinnacle	Winter Squash. Hybrid. Johnny's Selected Seeds.	Mid-sized spaghetti squash. Pinnacle has slightly a sweet, nutty flavor, and bright yellow skin. Average 3 lbs each, very uniform size.

Squash, Yellow Crookneck	Summer Squash. Organic. Heirloom. Seeds of Change.	This easy-to-grow, heirloom, yellow summer squash produces abundant fruits with graceful necks that are famous for flavor.
Swiss Chard, Bright Lights Mix	Multicolored mix, Johnny's Selected Seeds.	Green leaves with stems of many colors including pink, red, purple, yellow and white. Produces throughout the summer.

Tomatillo, Verde	Green. High Desert Seeds.	These tomatillos are a tangy, zesty and sweet addition to salsas, salad dressing or soups. This is an early maturing variety that produces large fruit.
Tomato, Boxcar Willie	Beefsteak. Indeterminate. Heirloom, Snake River Seed Cooperative.	A rare heirloom beefsteak. This uniform variety holds up well after picking, with a pleasant tomato flavor. Bred by country music legend and radio DJ Boxcar Willie.
Tomato, Carbon	Heirloom, organic, indeterminate. Johnny's Selected Seeds.	Highly productive black heirloom with excellent flavor. Blocky round, 10-14 oz. fruit with dark olive shoulders fading into a very dark, brick red. Boasts the signature rich flavor and meaty texture of a classic black tomato.
Tomato, Cherokee Purple	Heirloom, Organic. Indeterminate. Johnny's Selected Seeds.	An unusual variety with full flavor. The famously rich flavor and texture make this a colorful favorite among heirloom enthusiasts. Medium-large, flattened globe, 8-12 oz. fruits. Color is dusky pink with dark shoulders. Interior ranges from purple to brown to green. Relatively short vines.
Tomato, Red Brandywine	Heirloom, Indeterminate, Slicer. Organic. Johnny's Selected Seeds.	An all-time classic heirloom with a luscious flavor described as rich, loud, and distinctively spicy. Large, semi-flattened, deep-red fruit on large vines. The "Quisenberry" strain, considered one of the best.
Tomato, Dr. Wyche's Yellow.	Organic, Indeterminate. Seed Savers Exchange.	This variety has bright, golden yellow fruits that grow up to one pound. Meaty flesh with good flavor and high yields.
Tomato, Jaune Flamme	Heirloom, Indeterminate, Slicer. Organic. Seed Savers Exchange.	A YGP favorite. These apricot-orange fruits can grow to 4 ounces when supported. Highly productive. They maintain their rich orange color even when dried.
Tomato, Candy Cherry	Cherry. Indeterminate. Seed Savers Exchange.	Gorgeous bicolor cherry tomatoes are red with a spectacular cat's eye starburst on the blossom end. Rich, sweet, fruity flavor. Plants are loaded with 1½" fruits in clusters of 6-8.
Tomato, Indigo	Cherry.	Striking, dark blue coloration and red flesh in this improved Indigo variety. A vigorous

Tomato, Beam's Yellow Pear	Heirloom, Indeterminate, Pear. Seed Savers Exchange.	The tall, vigorous vines supply of 3/4-1 oz, yellow, pear shaped fruits with mild flavor. Perfect for salads or snacking.
Tomato, Tasmanian Chocolate.	Organic, slicer. Determinate. Johnny's Selected Seeds.	Delicious slicer for small spaces. A small plant with abundant flavor, it is well-suited for patios and containers (owing to its tidy plant habit and short stature) and only needs a standard tomato cage for support. These burgundy 4–6 oz., ribbed tomatoes are richly flavored and perfect for slicing onto sandwiches.
Watermelon, Moon and Stars	Baker Creek Heirloom Seeds.	Legendary heirloom variety.. Can grow to over 40 lbs. The dark green rind has bright yellow spots on it! Spots range in size from tiny to several inches across. Leaves are also specked in yellow. It has very sweet, brilliant red flesh.
Watermelon, Sugar Baby	Organic. Seeds of Change.	Tender 10-12 lb. fruits. Suitable for a small garden, this variety has compact vines and produces an abundance of small, flavorful red-orange fruits with near black rinds.
